They even had a garland of flowers to go around our neck once we walked down the road by our cabin and into our house. They asked Ray the pilot to join in with us too. I think he was amazed!! Our cabin

was all decorated too. We had to shake hands with just about every lady then we could go into the cabin. Afterwards they had cooked a lovely mu mu. Pig, chicken, sweet potato, pumpkin, green leaves etc. I can't believe that they did all this for us. They were so glad to see us and
