Oliver Allmand-Smith

I grew up as the youngest of six, and although we enjoyed many blessings as a family my childhood was rather troubled, especially after my 17-year-old brother was killed on a motorbike when I was only 10. I knew the message of the gospel, but I had no peace because my heart was not right with God. However, when I reached the age of 17 myself, God showed me mercy and gave me a new heart – I was re-born as a child of God knowing forgiveness of sins and peace with Him.

After University, I began working in industry as part of a family engineering company that has been continually trading in Macclesfield since 1810. In 1995 I married Alison, then we were called to the pastorate here in Ramsbottom in 1998. God has blessed us with six children. During our time of service here we have rejoiced to see the church grow in numbers, but also in the grace and knowledge of Christ and His word. We were especially encouraged in 2011 when the church adopted the 1689 London Baptist Confession as our statement of faith.



Billy McCurrie

I was born in Belfast and grew up in the 60's in a very happy, loving home. At the start of "The Troubles" on Saturday 27th June 1970, my Dad was shot dead by the IRA. Overnight my home life was plunged into grief. In 1974 age 16, I joined a loyalist terror group (UVF) and on March 8th 1976 (age 17) I was arrested for a murder that took place two weeks earlier.

Finding myself on remand in the Maze Prison I was eventually sentenced to be detained on 12th May 1977. On Christmas Eve 1980, I became a Christian and I moved away from violence due to my conversion experience. I was released from prison December in 1985. I went on to study for the Christian Ministry and am currently a Baptist Pastor in Ormskirk Lancashire.
