**Greetings from Thailand in the precious
Name of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ**

We thank everyone who is part of our journey in Thailand. May God bless you all for your financial and prayer support. We appreciate it. **“And may God supply all your needs according to His riches in glory in Christ Jesus.” Phil 4:19.** We had visitors from England in May. Benedict and his wife, Isabel, and daughter (Sofia) came to visit us for a week. Benedict who is a pastor was also involved teaching at one of our workshops. They came to “scout out the land” and are considering serving God in South East Asia and possibly in Thailand. **Pray for them that God would make his call clear to them in the coming months.** Jesus said: “The harvest is plentiful, but the workers are few” (Matt 9:25). “Pray then to the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers.”

By God’s grace our church is doing well, Matt and I have started preaching through Genesis. We also continue teaching through the 1689 Baptist confession, and Roxanne and Danielle are teaching the children. We are starting a Thai service this month, and I have been invited to preach at a church in Mae Ai in Thai. This will be my first sermon in Thai! **Please pray that God would help me to be clear and coherent as I speak. Pray also that our church would be a blessing to all those who come and as we reach Thai speakers.** We are currently in Malaysia and are applying for Nicolas’ and Roxanne’s Visas. Roxanne will start teaching Kindergarten as a volunteer at CRICS in August, an international Christian school in Chiang Rai. **Pray for Roxanne as she prepares herself for this new challenge.** She is excited and preparing her room and all sorts of things. **Pray also for Nicolas who will start Grade 1 at CRICS in August.** I also switched to a volunteer visa and am working for the Way Foundation. I have started teaching at a high school on substance abuse. I do this in English and praying for openings to share the gospel. It is a government school. **Pray for me as I prepare my lessons and my classes.** In May we had a group of twelve men (some pastors) from Laos again in Chiang Rai. Matt, Benedict and I taught workbook 2 on the doctrine of salvation and Christ. We had a wonderful time. Matt taught a workshop: “Christ in the Old Testament” this month in Mae Ai and next month we will be teaching workbook 3 (on ethics and family) to the group from Laos in Chiang Rai. I have booked my tickets to go to India again. I will be doing Workbook 3 with one group. I hoped to visit

the other groups in a India as well, but I have to be back in Thailand to report at immigration. **Pray for our workshops and that the pastors that come would learn a lot and retain what they learn and apply it to their own lives and to their congregations.** We have such a treasure in Christ and in the gospel and in the doctrines of grace. We need a wider and deeper appreciation of God and the gospel. One of my contacts in India is constantly asking for more Bibles to give to new believers. If you would like to make a donation towards that please let me know. Another pastor is constantly asking for sponsors for his orphan children. We handed out new Bibles to the group from Laos in May. These are the first physical copies they have had. We fund our workshops from donations we get from our sponsors. If you would like to make a donation towards our trips and sound theological training of pastors in the majority world, please let me know. We also have National Missionary partners who do workshops now that we have trained them. One of them, Jeebit in India, was in a motorcycle accident last week. He has been discharged from hospital **but pray for his recovery .**

We ordinarily pay for the lunch and study material and for our own transport and

Thailand. The Way Foundation for whom I work has asked Timothy Two International to lead the organization. **Please pray that God's will to be done.** If this materializes it may open more doors for ministry. Also it would make it easier for international visitors and teachers to get long-term Visas. **Also, pray that we might start a possible internship for a Thai national at our church.** We think
