Simeon writes: Greetings and peace in our Saviours precious Name.

It gives me joy to report that we are keeping well as all the children and staff have been kept free of Covid19 for which we thank the Lord for his protection and care keeping them in good health. We have faithfully instituted all the distancing, hygiene and other requirements imposed by the Government Health Authorities.

We are sad to report that Carlota Micas father passed away in hospital on the 16th of May after an illness. Carlota has been the House of Ants secretary and a member of the admin team since the days of Delci Santos. We would value your prayers for her and the family.

We have now finalised the 1st stage of the process of legalising the centre which will enable us to produce goods for sale to the public, and at the same time train young folk for possible future careers. In Mozambique these processes can take time as there are a great deal of "red tape" issues. However, we are still hoping to finalise the initial part of the project by the 2nd half of 2021, to this end we have ordered equipment which is vital for printing and design needs. None of this is produced in Mozambique and has had to be imported. To date the cost for these machines are in the region of \$10,000 USD dollars.

Protection of vulnerable children.

We were recently invited by the government to participate in the National Week for the Protection of the Child. This involves a two week discussion forum in ways to improve the lives of vulnerable children amongst other relevant topics.

Here are details of 3 children which have recently come to the House of Ants, either by Social Services requests or by dependants who are unable to care for them adequately.

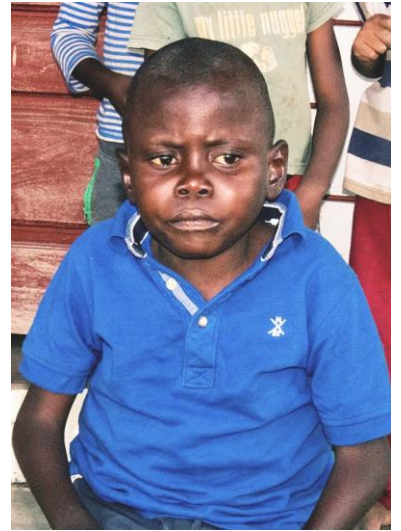
Percina Cumba & Junior Cumba.

Percina is 10 and Junior 6 years old, they are brother and sister. Percina is in year 5 and Junior year 1 at school. Since they don't actually live in the House of Ants, they come in daily for schooling, food and other assistance due to their father being unemployed. Both are happy children and ready to learn, particularly in the Bible teaching classes.



Paulo André Selé (known as Guifty)

Paulo André is 12 years old and lived with a carer which he called his grandmother. The house was very small and 6 other members lived in the same room. He is small for his age, cannot speak and is immobilised in his lower body and legs, needing total care. He is also HIV positive from birth. He was sent to us by the Social Services, as he was vulnerable with the family he was living with.
