- That academics and students will feel able to speak freely at our universities;
- For our ongoing work on a Street Preachers' Charter.

'CONVERSION THERAPY' LAWS

Activists want to outlaw preaching, prayer, pastoral care and parenting that do not align with their LGBT theology.

PLEASE PRAY:

- For our Let Us Pray campaign as it seeks to help Christians understand the dangers of a broad new law against 'conversion therapy';
- Giving thanks that the Scottish Government has acknowledged the legal difficulties surrounding its proposals for a new law;
- That the planned draft Bill at Westminster will be dropped;
- That churches and parents will remain free to teach faithfully on sexual ethics.

Wednesday

SANCTITY OF LIFE

PLEASE PRAY:

- That politicians and wider society will recognise the evil of abortion and do more to protect mothers and the unborn.

TRANSGENDER IDEOLOGY

Transgender ideology seeks to destroy the distinction between men and women that God in his wisdom has created.

PLEASE PRAY:

- With thanksgiving for increasing recognition of the harms of transgender ideology;
- That the UK's temporary bans on prescribing puberty blockers to gender-questioning children will be made permanent;
- Giving thanks that the Cass Review's recommendations to protect vulnerable children from irreversible medical intervention are being widely adopted;
- That trans-affirming lobby groups will lose influence in the public square.
