

## 2024.September. Internship Report

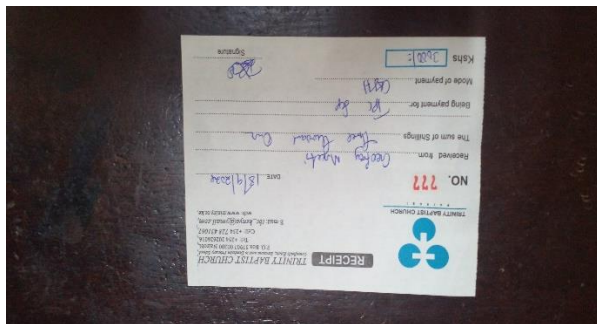
Dear brethren,
